## 12. ARREST, DETENTION AND LITIGATION (Details)

On May 17, 1982 several friends and I were at the Jack in the Box restaurant located at 61<sup>st</sup> & Avenue R ½ in Galveston, Texas. While in the restaurant, two white males and their girlfriends came into the restaurant and immediately began having words with one of my friends. Shortly thereafter, a fight broke out between my friend and one of the male subjects. The second male subject jumped in to assist his friend. At this point, I stepped in to assist my friend. The fight lasted approximately five minutes. After the fight, all parties involved left the restaurant without further incident.

Approximately two weeks later, Joe Giusti, a police officer with the Galveston Police Department contacted me. Officer Giusti stated that the gentleman we got into a fight with at the Jack in the Box had filed charges on my friend and me. Officer Giusti then stated that he had a warrant for my arrest. Later that afternoon, I met officer Giusti at my parent's house and turned myself in. I was then transported to the City jail where I was processed. After being processed, I was transported to the County Jail. I was released on a PR Bond.
