| <p>09-02-04: Director of Special Services and Curriculum Robert Bodisch reported that licensee Fullen may have duplicate hours posted on his training record. Director Bodisch said Fullen had been issued a Master Peace Officer Certificate in October 2003 based on submission of the MPOC application and an attached TCLEDDS printout, showing 2776 training hours. The MPOC application did state that the reviewing TCLEOSE employee should see the TCLEDDS printout for total number of hours.</p> <p>Director Bodisch pointed out that the internal TCLEDDS record did show the following questionable information:</p> <p><i>Course # 1004 Advanced Reserve Officer 12/12/1986 256 College of the Mainland LEA</i> <i>Course # 1004 Advanced Reserve Officer 12/12/1986 256 Academy Test 5</i> <i>Course # 1003 Intermediate Reserve Officer 08/29/1986 245 College of the Mainland LEA</i> <i>Course # 1003 Intermediate Reserve Officer 08/29/1986 245 Academy Test 5</i> <i>Course # 1002 Basic Reserve Officer 04/04/1986 College of the Mainland LEA</i> <i>Course # 1002 Basic Reserve Officer 04/04/1986 Academy Test 5.</i></p> <p>I added up ALL of the hours showing on the TCLEDDS report and they did total 2,776. However, it appears that duplicate credit was given for the classes listed above. As such, Fullen has 712 hours that were given in error. He shows to have 16 years, 1 month service time. Subtracting the duplicate hours would give him a total of 2,064 hours. Current commission guidelines require 15 years of service and 2,400 training hours or 20 years and 1,200 training hours. Fullen does not meet those requirements. The MPOC was issued in error and is subject to cancellation. It appears that Fullen relied on errant data from the TCLEDDS database to obtain his certificate. Mr. Fullen received his Master PO certificate based upon the number of hours showing in his TCLEDDS report. However, there were three courses that were duplicates. Those courses should have been removed. Under the revised training record, he would not have had the proper combination of time and training to get the MPOC. I forwarded our case over to ELS based on this matter alone.

With regard to Fullen not taking his Chief's training, I don't know why that letter was generated; my case had nothing to do with Chief's initial or Continuing Education training (Education Code).
