commission guidelines require 15 years of service and 2,400 training hours or 20 years and 1,200 training hours. Fullen										
does not meet those requirements. The MPOC was issued in error and is subject to cancellation. It appears that Fullen

I forwarded our case over to ELS based on this matter alone.

With regard to Fullen not taking his Chief's training, I don't know why that letter was generated; my case had nothing to do with Chief's initial or Continuing Education training (Education Code).
